1. WASHING



Machine wash



Hand wash



Wash cold / 30°C



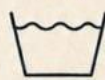
Warm wash / 40°C



Hot wash / 60°C



Permanent press



Delicate / gentle cycle



Do not wash

2. BLEACHING



Bleach if needed



Non-chlorine bleach only



Do not bleach

3. DRYING



Tumble dry



Tumble dry low



Tumble dry medium



Tumble dry high



Do not tumble dry



Line dry



Drip dry



Dry flat



Dry in shade

4. IRONING



Iron okay



Low heat



Medium heat



High heat



Do not iron



Do not steam

5. DRY CLEANING



Dry clean



Professional dry clean



Dry clean with hydrocarbons



Do not dry clean



Professional wet clean



Do not wet clean

QUICK NOTES

- * Dots inside drying and ironing symbols indicate heat level.
- * Lines underneath wash symbols indicate gentler cycles.
- * Crossed-out symbols mean avoid that method.
- * When in doubt, follow the garment care label.

Laundry Tips & Tricks

Simple habits for cleaner clothes and better results

BEFORE YOU WASH



Sort by color, fabric, and soil level.



Check the care label before washing.



Treat stains early for the best results.



Empty pockets and zip garments closed.

BETTER WASHING HABITS



Don't overload the washer — clothes need room to move.



Wash darks in cold water to help preserve color.



Turn graphics, denim, and delicate items inside out.



Use mesh bags for delicates and small items.

DRYING TIPS



Lower heat helps reduce shrinkage and fabric wear.



Remove clothes promptly to reduce wrinkles.



Air dry delicate fabrics when possible.



Dry towels separately for better absorbency.

STAIN & FABRIC TIPS



Blot stains instead of rubbing them deeper.



Test stain removers on an inside seam first.



Skip fabric softener on activewear and towels.



Wool, silk, and embellished items need extra care.

WHY DETERGENT SHEETS?

- ★ Pre-measured and easy to use.
- ★ No bulky jugs and less mess.
- ★ Lightweight and easy to store.
- ★ Great for home, travel, dorms, and small spaces.
- ★ A low-waste alternative to traditional liquid detergent.



BEST RESULTS WITH DETERGENT SHEETS

- ★ Place the sheet in the drum first or tuck it down among the clothes.
- ★ Use the right amount for your load size.
- ★ For very small loads, use less if the product directions allow it.
- ★ For extra-large or heavily soiled loads, use more if needed.
- ★ Make sure the sheet can contact water freely and dissolve fully.
